APPOINTED PASTOR of St. Mary, Westphalia, is the Rev. James Schmitt, who has been serving as administrator of that parish due to the illness and recent death of the Rev. Al Miller.

The Rev. Mark Santo, OSM, has been assigned as chaplain to Milan Federal Prison, Milan.

Assignment of the Rev. Andrew Dunne, OSFS, as pastor of Our Lady of Fatima, Michigan Center, has also been announced. He replaces the Rev. Paul Gillespie, OSFS, who has been reassigned by his religious order.

THE REV. Leo Quinn, OSFS, has been appointed associate pastor at Michigan Center.

Priests of the Diocese have been informed of the vacancy at St. Pius in Flint, and may apply for that pastorate to the Personnel Committee.
