



Independent Reconciliation and **Compensation Programs in New York**

In October 2016, at the request of Cardinal Timothy Dolan, the Archdiocese of New York announced a compensation program for sexual abuse survivors called the Independent Reconciliation and Compensation Program (IRCP). The Archdiocese hired the Law Offices of Kenneth Feinberg to serve as program administrators. According to program administrators, the objective of the IRCP is, "to compensate victims of clergy sexual abuse of minors by acknowledging the abuse and promoting some degree of reconciliation between the Church and its innocent victims."

In 2017, the Diocese of Brooklyn and the Diocese of Rockville Centre announced similar programs and in 2018, the Dioceses of Syracuse, Buffalo and Ogdensburg followed suit. Each of the programs placed certain limitations on who could submit claims, including the exclusion of survivors sexually abused by a member of a religious order or those abused by priests who worked in the diocese, but were not diocesan priests. Additionally, the Dioceses of Syracuse, Buffalo and Ogdensburg have only made the program available to survivors who previously reported the abuse, excluding those survivors who have been suffering in silence and have not reported their abuse to the diocese. With the exception of the Diocese of Buffalo, all other Dioceses retained Mr. Feinberg's office to administer their programs.

The IRCP has provided some measure of justice to the survivors who qualify, but there are many deficiencies in the program that can and should be changed. The evaluation process conducted by the program administrators is confidential and survivors are not provided with access to documents or files on their perpetrators. After a survivor submits his or her claim to the program, it can take months to determine eligibility. If a survivor is offered compensation and his or her claim has been deemed "substantiated," the survivor then must choose whether to accept the offer or reject it. If a survivor accepts the offer, he or she agrees to waive all future rights to litigation against the diocese.

According to program administrators Ken Feinberg and Camille Biros, as of September 2018 at least 1,260 claims were filed with the various programs; 1,100 determinations had been made; and at least

980 individuals had accepted the compensation offers. Approximately \$200 million had been distributed amongst the various programs to sexual abuse survivors.

While these programs may be helpful to some, survivors of sexual abuse deserve their day in court. Transparency and accountability cannot be accomplished by confidential programs administered by the very institution that betrayed these survivors to begin with. The files and documents pertaining to the perpetrators still remain secret, as well as information on what top officials were complicit in the cover-up of these horrific crimes. Compensation programs are not the solution. Only when the courtroom doors are open and the statute of limitations is changed, can survivors begin to heal.

Transparency and Accountability

The identities of survivors who make claims are protected and held strictly confidential. While the IRCPs do provide some financial compensation, there is no requirement for Church officials to disclose the identities, histories or whereabouts of any of the alleged perpetrators against whom allegations have been substantiated. Accordingly, the programs, while not preventing a survivor from speaking out, allow Church officials to maintain secrecy over their activities, actions, complicity and cover-up. The alleged perpetrators identified herein are all subject to substantiated claims settled through the IRCP programs.

This information contains the names of clergy associated with the Archdiocese of New York, Diocese of Brooklyn, Diocese of Rockville Centre, Diocese of Syracuse and Diocese of Ogdensburg who have been accused of sexual misconduct. IRCP claims against these individuals have been settled by the dioceses and have not been evaluated in a civil court. Accordingly, the allegations should be considered just allegations and not be considered proven or substantiated in a court of law. All individuals should be considered innocent until proven guilty. In most situations, the statute of limitations has expired preventing the cases from being heard in a court of law.




