

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- Prior to that time he is believed to have been a Priest at St. Patrick's on 32 Beech Street in Newport, New Hampshire but I still need to confirm this.
- Fr. Cote was not associated with St. Joseph's or St. Mary's in Claremont except personnel from St. Mary's did inform me that Fr. Cote would teach certain educational programs at the Christian Life Center in Claremont, which has long ago closed its doors. The recollection is that Fr. Cote would travel over from Newport. This would have been sometime in the 80's. I'll try to dig up more information.




