

Rev. Stanislaus A. Bur, 88 of Cheboygan, passed away Sunday, February 1, 2009 at Hancock Haven Retirement Village. Rev. Bur was a senior priest of the Saginaw Diocese.... Rev. Bur was born September 7, 1920 in Riggsville, the son of Joseph and Josephine (Blank) Bur. He studied for the priesthood at St. Joseph Seminary, Grand Rapids, MI, Sacred Heart Seminary, Detroit, MI, and St. Mary's Seminary, Baltimore, Maryland. He was ordained June 3, 1950 by Bishop Francis J. Haas at St. Andrews Cathedral, Grand Rapids, MI. During his priesthood, Rev. Bur served as assistant pastor at parishes in Grand Rapids, Beal City, Hastings, Traverse City, Muskegon, and Ionia, MI. He served as pastor in Maple City, Beal City, Kinde, Pinnebog, and Beaver, MI. He enjoyed gardening, working in his Christmas trees and making maple syrup, traveling, playing cards, fishing, and was a member of the Knights of Columbus. Surviving are two sisters, Dorothy Clark and Gertrude Miller, both of Cheboygan, three brothers, Ernest Bur of Cheboygan, Ben (Margaret) Bur of Riggsville, Donald (Midge) Bur of Boulder Junction, Wisconsin, sister-in-law Mary Bur of Cheboygan, and many nieces, nephews, and cousins. He was preceded in death by his parents, two sisters, Genevieve Weiss and Loretta Bur, and seven brothers, Leonard, Raymond, Lawrence, Frank,

George, Edmund, and Tom Bur.
