If you're one of those many Catholics who say you're interested in joining a good Bible-study group, have I got news for you!

We've got another Bible-study course forming up later this month. The area of study will be the prophet Isaiah. The group will meet every Friday (except Good Friday) from March 21 through June 20. They'll meet for those 13 sessions in the Conference Room of the Parish Office Building from 10:30 to 12:00 noon. The course will range throughout the prophetic book and look closely at such themes from Isaiah as "God's Faithfulness to the People and to Jerusalem," "The Work and Suffering of the Servant," "Judgments and Calls to Repentance," and "Promises and Visions of Salvation." Another spiritual concern for many people is receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation as part of their preparation for the Easter Triduum. You might want to go ahead and mark your family calendar for our two communal Lenten Penance services; they're slated for Sunday, April 6 (3:00 p.m.), and Monday, April 7 (7:30 p.m.). Father David or I will also be available for individual confessions for about an hour on Tuesday, April 15 (7:00 p.m.), and Wednesday, April 16 (12:00 noon and 6:00 p.m.). The bulletin editor will also soon be listing Penance liturgies in some of our neighboring parishes, where you're more than welcome to receive the sacrament.

Finally, I pray that your Lenten journey may be deeply spiritually fruitful for you! ----- Father Mike

HIPPA-Rules & Regulations for Healthcare

The Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPPA) has four goals and objectives that will eventually impact on the public:

1. Assures health insurance portability when you change jobs—eliminates some pre-existing condition exclusions.
2. Reduce healthcare fraud and abuse thru administrative simplification and medical liability reform.
3. Enforce standards for health information—prohibits discrimination based on health status.
4. Guarantee security and privacy of health information to be transferred confidentially from one department to another and to other institutions.
