

In 1891 Pope Leo XIII wrote <u>Rerum Novarum</u> an encyclical about the abuses of the early industrialization of the world decrying, unsafe working condition, long working hours and the workers right to form unions. For over 100 years, many Catholics living in the South embraced the "Jim Crow laws" of segregation. Pope Francis encyclical may also have a prescient quality so that the truths of this document will be clearer and more acceptable as time passes.

The Social Justice Committee will offer opportunities in the fall to familiarize you with this encyclical and explore its' meaning and application in our lives.

We have been informed that Rev. Harold Quigg petitioned the Vatican to change his status from priest to lay person. That petition has been approved.
