I met with **Example** and encouraged him to seek counseling to address his anger around these matters. He said he would do so once this matter was settled.

I told him that there was no insurance to cover the allegations he has made because at that time the Archdiocese had total charitable immunity. I also pointed out that I felt that he was in great deal of pain and that money would not settled even though it might ease it.

I mentioned that we didn't want to haggle about the amount he was requested to settle this but that the Archdiocese is strapped financially. It has been operating in a deficit operation for a couple million dollars each year for the past few years.

He said that he would be willing to reduce the request to \$40,000. He also agreed to sign a release after reading a release form provided by Wilson Rogers.

He would like to settle this soon. He had been intending to speak to Attorney MacLeish if the Archdiocese continued to drag its feet in this matter. Once a final release form and arrangements for payment of the settlement are made, I will contact him at his home number:
