But dica't respond, and the whole thing ended.

has realized that what happened was unwholesome and is worried that PM may be doing the same-or worse--to other young men. convinced him that he needed to report it to the seems to be at ease with the whole matter now that he has had the chance to talk about it. However, my suspicion is that some counseling would be helpful. I told him that, and he thinks he doesn't need it. Given the intensity and the great detail with which he told the story (I had to interrupt several times to move it along) I think he needs to do some more work on it. committed young Catholic quite knowledgeable about the Church. Although what happened was not very overt it did disturb him very much.

about our misconduct policies and that normally I would not have spoken with him alone. He is quite willing to speak with a committee. His does not want any publicity. He specially doesn't want his parents to know about it. I assured him of complete confidentiality.
