Your Excellency:

Today 16, 1954 is the 24th anniversary of my ordination to the Priesthood and I take this commemorable opportunity to renew my request for incardination into the Diocese of San Diego where I have worked almeady for over a year under your guidance and since I feel very happy in Your Diocese and I deeply appreciate the kindness Your Excellency has shown to me, I have a great desire to be fully attached to the Diocese of San Diego at your earliest convinience if Your Excellency thinks that I am worthy of this great privelege.

Following the advise Your Excellency gave me in the Rectory of East Highlands when we talked about that matter on the 8th of this month I will make a brief narration of the events since my coming to your Diocese.

I came to the Diocese of San Diego on March 13, 1953 and I was assigned to St. Joseph's Cathedral. On April 14th 1955 I was appointed assistant to the Right Rev. Msgr. Joseph R. Nuñez, Pastor of Our Lady of Guadalupe, San Bernardino, California. On June the 2nd, I made my first application for incardination into the Diocese of San Diego and at that date I sent to the Chancery Office the original Rescript of my secularization praevio experimento in which it is stated that Your Excellency is the executer, and can incardinate me "transacto experimento tempore, vel etiam prius". By the order of Your Excellency The Very Rev. James T. Booth J.C.D. Vice-Chancellor at that time answered to my request on June 3rd. saying: "that His Excellency wishes to assure you that your request for incardination into the Diocese of San Diego will receive every consideration possible". In the meanwhile I was request to send to the Chancery Office a recent health certificate and a Chest X-ray as a further requirement, what I did immediately.

Maybe the untrue charge that Fr. Dominic Morera S.F. made againts me in a letter to Your Excellency September 15, 1953 had something to do first to postpone my incardination. On November 4, 1953 Your Excellency wrote me to answer these charges directly to Fr. Dominic Morera S.F. submitting to him "An accurate and forthright statement of facts" and to send a copy of this statement to Your Excellency. I did that on November 6, 1953. The Very Rev. Vice-Chancellor following your instructions wrote me on the 8th of November that this statement had been received by Your Excellency. On December 10th. I received the answer from Fr. Dominic Morera S.F. and he sent a letter of the same tenor or a copy to Your Excellency in which he din't seem very pleased of my letter November 6, 1954. I answered that letter on the 21st. of December explaining everything and telling Fr. Dominic Morera S.F. not to bother me any more. This letter is very long about eight pages of typewrinting and I sent a copy to Father General Rt. Rev. Martin Millet S.F. who lives in Barcelona, Spain. Fr. General gave me the permission to come to your Diocese and sent to Your Excellency the confidential letter about my person before I was admitted to the Diocese of San Diego.

Sice that letter December 21, 1953, Fr. Dominic Morera S.F. has not writen me any more, and I am sure that Fr. General told him not to bother me again for anything. Fr. General on the 28th of December wrote me a short note telling me that he had received the copies of the letters I sent

to Fr. Dominic Morera S.F. and thanked me for the information I had given to him. Enclosed is the original of Fr. General's note.

To clear up all this wickedness of Fr. Dominic Morera against me I paied a visit to Your Excellency on January 29 and explained all the questions Your Excellency made to me and I left your Office with the assurance that everyting had been clered up. This assurance of Your Excellency gave me courage to ask again for my incardination and your promise that it would be granted provided that I make the petition in writing. I thought would be the best thing to make this petition in the anniversary of my ordination to the pristhood which took place in Barcelona on the 16 of March 1930.

Dear Father Rosell:

I have read your last letter and have faithfully compared it with the one you have received from the Most Reverend Charles F. Buddy, Bishop of San Diego. I have found, in this comparison, that you neither "clarigy the situation" nor "submit an accurate and forthright statement of facts."

According to the indicated instructions of his Excellency you state "there was an agreement to tell the people you went to San Diego to establish there a new foundation to avoid scandal." Was such fair to the Diocese? A letter from Father M. Millet, S.F. of April 27, 1953, clearly forbade you to misrepresent the facts of the situation to the friends of the Congregation.

On March 14, 1953, you gave a written order to the Postmaster of Firebaugh, California, directing that all mail bearing your name be forwarded to you. You made no distinction concerning Nazareth House or Post Office Box 923. It appears that your orders were fairly well followed. It also seems evident that much of the mail involved was actually intended for the Congregation.

In your letter you admit having received some donations and a number of Mass intentions. Do you consider yourself as justified in celebrating some of these Masses and giving the intentions for the rest of them to others for celebration? Your attention is directed to the statement of His Excellency entreating with you, to the effect that "you will see the justice and the necessity of returning these funds immediately."

I am neither minded nor able to stop you from soliciting Mass intentions but it would seem to me that it ought to be obvious to you that by so doing you seriously endanger your status with your ecclesiastical superiors. The S.F. I shall never try to take away from you, and hope and pray that you live and die in the meaning of these initials.

"Very Rev. and Dear Fr. in J,M.J.: I have just received a letter from the Most Rev. Bishop of San Diego in which He tells me of the serious charges you made againts ped, in a letter September 15, 1953 in which you affirm that I "still seek to maintain control over the Community fiscal business" and that "I receive mail and solicit funds in the name of the Community" and that I misrepresent myself as a member of the Congregation.

As the Most Rev. Bishop in His letter tells me to write to you and make a stament of facts a am going to do that briefly.

In the first place when I came to the Diocese of San Diego it was understood between Fr. General and myethat I and the Community of Firebaugh will tell people and friends that I went to San Diego for a new foundation to avoid a possible scandal. I explain my case to some friends in that way but as soon as have known that the Fathers of Firebaugh told friends that I left the Congregation I started to tell my frineds the same. In the beginning I was in San Diego it is true I received some little donations, the most part of them consisting of Mass Intentions which I took care of them. Besides yourself schowed to Fr. General a letter that I wrote to Mrs. Rios who sent me to Mass intentions and since Fr. General on account

of that latter wrote me not to ask in the name of the Congregation I stopped completely and promise him to ask my friends in the future in my name and Fr, General told me that that would be much better and that I was smart enaugh to make friends by myself. And if later on I have received some Mass intentions from friends that used to send them to me when I was in the Congregation and have never asked them in the name of the Congregation but only in my name and if I have signed my letters with the initials S.F. it is because I am not yet incardinated to the Diocese and while I am not incardinated I still belong to the Order at least canonically.

Be sure Fr. Morera that I do not intend to do you and evil, but I don't believe that you and anybody else can forbid me to write to my friends in my own name and ask them what I want. If some of my friends has send me some Mass intentions and they thought it was for the Congregation and you can prove that I will refund you all the stipends. And be sure in the future I will never will ask anything but in my name and telling them that I do not belong any longer to the Congregation.

Returning to my desk yesterday morning from the Ad Limina visit to Rome, it was a matter of deep regret to find a letter from Greeley, Colorado which contained serious charges against you.

It is understood and has been made a matter of record that having been separated from your Religious Congregation known as the "Sons of the Holy Family" you thereby surrendered all business relations and terminated any position or authority that you enjoyed in the said Congregation of the Sons of the Holy Family.

It is now alleged that you "still seek to maintain a control over the community fiscal business" and that you "receive mail and solicit funds in the name of the Community". It is furthermore alleged that you misrepresent yourself as a member of the Sons of the Holy Family.

While no documentary evidence has been submitted to this Chancery that the allegations are true in whole or in part, permit me to advise you to clarify the situation without further delay. If through some oversight or misunderstanding you have received funds in the name of the Sons of the Holy Family or collected funds on their behalf, you will see the justice and the necessity of returning these funds immediately to the Reverend Dominic Morera, S.F. who writes me that he is the lawful representative of his Order.

Dear Father Rossell, you can understand that any irregularaties or violations of truth or justice in this regard could lead to very serious consequences.

You owe it to yourself, then, and to your reputation as a priest to write without delay to

Most Rev. and Dear Bishop Buddy:

The writer is the Provincial in the United States of the religious order known as the "Sons of the Holy Family". I am also President of the incorporated body, known as the Sons of the Holy Family, Inc., a Colorado corporation of long standing. Prior to his joining the Diocese of San Diego, we had as a member of our religious community, Father Joseph Rosell, who is now stationed under your authority, last reported at San Bernardino, California.

While he was a member of our community, Father Rosell had certain authority connected with the business affairs of our order. He had his headquarters at Firebaugh, California, and there he received the mail addressed to him, in his capacity, as our representative and to our order. Upon his seperation from our community we had a mutual understanding, expressly treated in writing, that all his authority concerning the business of our order was terminated and Father then promised that he would have no further contact with our affairs.

Lately it has been reported to me that Father Rosell still seeks to maintain a control over our community fiscal business. He is receiving our mail and soliciting and keeping funds asked for in the name of our community. There is no doubt about the fact of these practices because I have definite and ample proof that Father Rosell is still holding himself out, for business reasons, as a member of and representative of the Sons of the Holy Family.

There is involved, I am informed, a violation of the postal laws of the United States in connection with the conduct of Father Rosell.

I regret exceedingly the necessity of your Excellency's attention to this matter, but the practice seems to involve a rather substantial right and purpose on the part of lather Rosell to continue it.

May I ask a proper directive from your Excellency forbidding Father Rosell from any further contact-with the affairs, the management or the funds of our community and that he be ordered to turn over to me, as the representative of my order, all records that properly belong to our community and all funds collected on our behalf.

Knowing that I shall have your Excellency's cooperation and that you shall find the facts as I have stated them, and offering to present proof if you require, I remain,





Most Rev. and Dear Bishop:

Though I have not the pleasure to know Your Excellency in person nevertheless I feel that I em going to find in Your Excellency a father who will understand me and care for my present troubles.

I am a religious priest belonging to the Congregation "Sons of the Holy Family" since 1922. I am 45 years old and I was ordained on March 16, 1930 in Barcelona, Spain. From 1930 to 1934 I was a teacher in our Seminary in Barcelona. From 1934 to 1936 I have studied Canon and Civil Law in the Appollinaris Rome, From 1936 to 1939 I have tought latin and greec in the Minor Seminary in Bahia Blanca, Argentina, which Minor Seminary was under our care at that time. From 1939 to 1941, again I was in Rome studying Canon and Civil Law in the Pontificium Aeteneum Lateranense and in June 1941 I obtained de degree of Doctor in utroque Iure. In that Summer of 1941 I was appointed Secretary of the Father General and I remain int that appoinent till 1947 living in Barcelona, Spain the headquaters of our Congregation. In 1947 I came to this Country and after a while I was appointed Pastor of Holy Name of Mary Church, Del Norte, Colorado, Dioceses of Pueblo, in care of our Congregation. In 1950 I was sent to California to try to establish a Novitiate for our Order. We bought a property in Firebaugh, Diocese of Monterey-Fresno. The Novitiate has not been established yet and still is in pracess of formation.

My difficulties are that in many occasions I have desired to abandon the Congregation of the Sons of the Holy Family because I don't feel happy in it on account of many envies, criticism and a complete absense of religious charity.

Since a year ago for these reason and others I have ardently desired to leave the Congregation and look for a little happiness in the parochial life as a secular priest and do my best for the Salvation of my own soul and others.

It is about two months and a half I wrote to my Superior General asking him the permission to leave the Congregation and become a secular priest. He answer giving me good advices and telling me to think it over. I did and finally I wrote him saying that I have determined to abandon the Congregation and become a secular priest. I din't receive an answer to that letter.

I do know that the Sacred Congregation of Religious do not use to grant a decree of secularization without securing a "Benevolent bishop". For this reason I made a special trip to San Diego on the 21st of this month to ask Your Excellency if it would be possible for me to find a job in your Diocese at least "ad experimentum" and in the meanwhile Your Excellency would be able to know me. I was not lucky, Your Excellency were out, in a confirmation tour. I talked about that matter with Msgr. Francis Dillon, who has been very kind to me and let me to celebrate the Mass in the Cathedral, and treated me very kindly advising me to write this letter to Your Excellency.

So I humbly and respectfully ask Your Excellency to accept me in your Diocese at least ad experimentum. As soon as I have this permission I will write to the Sacred Congregation of Religious in Rome to obtain the decree of secularization or at least a temporal permit to reside in Your Diocese.
