## ~ FR. GREGORY C. CHISHOLM , SJ ~

### Msgr. John Meehan

Two weeks ago in the statement from the Archdiocese of New York concerning accusations against Msgr. Meehan was placed in our bulletin. The statement was written by the Office of the Vicar General, Msgr. Gregory Mustaciuolo. The Vicar General has the dual responsibility of helping those who are victims of sexual abuse in Archdiocesan institutions like churches or schools and he also is responsible for assessing the case against clergy or lay employees in the Church who are accused of sexual abuse. The statement from the Vicar General which was given out last week was a summary of his decision regarding accusations against Msgr. Meehan, but the statement does not reflect or acknowledge the continuing effort on the part of Msgr. Meehan to appeal the Vicar General's decision and restore his reputation.

### Standing In The Need of Prayer

During the Parish Council meeting held on September 9, 2018, following the Sunday Masses, Ms. Amy Campbell of our Church strongly suggested that our Parish community be engaged in prayer for victims of abuse, prayer for our parishioners who are suffering from the revelations about sexual abuse in the church, and prayer for those who are accused of violating the trust placed in them as clergy or church employees. I hope that several in our church will suggest ways in which we might take up Amy's prayer suggestion. However, I offer the following plan as a beginning. Our parish now has a Wednesday evening English Mass at 6:30pm. The doors of the church are opened for Mass at 6:00pm. ***I encourage any parishioners, who are able, to participate in a recitation of the Holy Rosary in St. Charles Borromeo on Wednesday evenings prior to the beginning of the Mass.*** The Rosary will be offered as a prayer of intercession to our Blessed Mother on behalf of sexual abuse victims in our Catholic Church, on behalf of parishioners who are suffering in this time and on behalf of those accused of violating their trust in our Church.

### Helping Victims in Their Time of Need

In all my years as Pastor at St Charles Borromeo, Resurrection and All Saints I have never doubted the resolve of our community to help men and women in need. We stand up for those who hunger. We stand with hurricane victims who cannot help themselves. We are shoulder to shoulder with victims of neighborhood violence and domestic violence. We are also in full support of any man or woman or child who has been sexually abused. Our parish is more aware now than ever of the pain, fear and struggle endured by those who have been sexually violated. Even as we express concern for those accused and even as we tend to our own suffering, we know who we are as Catholic Christians. We are the hands and heart of Jesus Christ offering shelter and hope to those in need.

If you are a victim of sexual abuse or sexual harassment by a member of our clergy or by an employee of our parish, please let me know or let the Office of the Vicar General of the Archdiocese of New York know (212-371-1000). Your concerns will be treated respectfully and confidentially.

### Mons. John Meehan

Dos semana atrás, se colocó en nuestro boletín una declaración de la Arquidiócesis de Nueva York sobre las acusaciones contra Mons. Meehan. La declaración fue escrita por la Oficina del Vicario General, Msgr. Gregory Mustaciuolo. El Vicario General tiene la doble responsabilidad de ayudar a quienes son víctimas de abuso sexual en instituciones Arquidiocesanas, como iglesias o escuelas, y también es responsable de evaluar el caso contra el clero o los empleados laicos de la Iglesia acusados de abuso sexual. La declaración del Vicario General que se entregó la semana pasada fue un resumen de su decisión con respecto a las acusaciones contra Mons. Meehan, pero la declaración no refleja ni reconoce el esfuerzo continuo de Mons. Meehan para apelar la decisión del Vicario General y restaurar su reputación .

### De Pie en la Necesidad de Orar

Durante la reunión del Consejo Parroquial celebrada el 9 de septiembre de 2018, después de las Misas dominicales, la Sra. Amy Campbell de nuestra Iglesia sugirió encarecidamente que nuestra comunidad parroquial participe en oración por las víctimas de abuso, oración por nuestros feligreses que sufren las revelaciones sobre abuso sexual en la iglesia, y oración por aquellos que están acusados de violar la confianza depositada en ellos como clérigos o empleados de la iglesia. Espero que varios en nuestra iglesia sugieran formas en las que podamos tomar la sugerencia de la oración de Amy. Sin embargo, ofrezco el siguiente plan como un comienzo. Nuestra parroquia ahora tiene una misa de inglés los miércoles a las 6:30 p.m. Las puertas de la iglesia están abiertas para la Misa a las 6:00 p.m. **Animo a los feligreses que puedan participar en una recitación del Santo Rosario en San Carlos Borromeo los miércoles por la noche antes del comienzo de la Misa.** El Rosario se ofrecerá como una oración de intercesión a nuestra Santísima Madre en nombre de víctimas de abuso sexual en nuestra Iglesia Católica, en nombre de feligreses que están sufriendo en este momento y en nombre de los acusados de violar su confianza en nuestra Iglesia.

### Ayudando a las Víctimas en su Momento de Necesidad

En todos mis años como pastor en San Carlos Borromeo, Resurrección y Todos los Santos, nunca he dudado de la determinación de nuestra comunidad de ayudar a hombres y mujeres necesitados. Defendemos a los que tienen hambre. Respaldamos a las víctimas del huracán que no pueden ayudarse a sí mismas. Estamos hombro con hombro con las víctimas de la violencia en el vecindario y la violencia doméstica. También estamos totalmente de acuerdo con cualquier hombre, mujer o niño que haya sido abusado sexualmente. Nuestra parroquia es más consciente ahora que nunca del dolor, el miedo y la lucha que sufren quienes han sido violados sexualmente. Incluso cuando expresamos nuestra preocupación por los acusados e incluso cuando atendemos nuestro propio sufrimiento, sabemos quiénes somos como cristianos católicos. Somos las manos y el corazón de Jesucristo ofreciendo refugio y esperanza a los necesitados.
