## Pastor of the week

PATTON — The Rev. William J. Valverde, 40, was appointed Catholic chaplain at Patton State Hospital effective July 1.

Valverde, a native of San Diego, is a 1954 graduate of St. Augustine High School in San Diego. He earned a B.A. degree in philosophy in 1961 from the University of San Diego.

He was ordained a priest in the Roman Catholic Church in 1962.

Valverde is working toward a master's degree in clinical psychology at the University of San Francisco.

His pastorates have included associate pastor at St. Mary's Star of the Sea, Oceanside, 1962-65; St. Mary's, El Centro, 1965-67; St. Joseph's, Upland, 1967-68; St. Edward's, Corona, 1968-70, and St. Mary's, Escondido, 1970-73. He served as pastor of St. Ann's, Needles, 1973-76.

Valverde served with the Sheriff's Department of San Diego County from April 1976 to July 1977 as Catholic chaplain at the central jail and as religious activities coordinator.
