Jr. of New Canaan, CT; William M., his wife Susan H. and their children, Nicholas M. and Christopher M. of Shaker Heights, OH; Harold H. Jr., his wife Jennifer B. and their children, Alyson M. and Aidan F. of Broomfield, CO; and Timothy E., his wife Tracy O. and their children, Ryan D. and Caitlin E. of Wheaton, IL.
