
'The Lenten Journey' mission at Our Lady of the Rosary

A three-night Lenten mission is being offered at 7:30 p.m. April 13-15, at Our Lady of the Rosary Church, 703 C St., Union City. The mission presenter is the Rev. J. Patrick Foley, a self-described "itinerant papist preacher."

Father Foley is well known and in recent weeks has given missions and retreats throughout the Western states plus Vermont and New York.

The mission presentations begin each night at 7:30 p.m. and are titled "The Lenten Journey — Christ's and yours." The pastor of Our Lady of the Rosary Church, Rev. José M. Leon, is inviting all neighboring parishes to attend — Fremont, Newark, Hayward and beyond. There is no admission charge.
