

ARCHDIOCESAN STATEMENT

The Archdiocese has been named as a defendant in a lawsuit alleging sexual abuse of a minor by Martin Juarez, a former diocesan priest, at St. Matthew Parish, Topeka, in the early 1980s. Juarez served at St. Matthew during that timeframe; he left priestly ministry in the Archdiocese in 1994 and was laicized in 2005.
