

Msgr. Stanton was ordained into the priesthood in 1949 and served many parishes and schools during his nearly 55 years as a priest. His last parish was St. Ambrose Church in God's Country, South Buffalo. He was as famous for his sense of humor as he was for his compassion for his fellow man. After his retirement, he continued to celebrate mass at various churches, usually telling the congregation that "their Pastor needed help and he was the only one hanging around the union hall that morning!". Father Stanton will be missed by everyone that had the pleasure of knowing him.
